Rules of Play

1. Scratch off « YOUR LETTERS » (« IHRE BUCHSTABEN ») one after the other.
2. Check whether the uncovered letters appear once or more in the crossword puzzles 1 and 2 as well as in the « BONUS WORD » (« BONUSWORT »).
3. Check if you have won:
 - You win the amount listed in the « PRIZE LEGEND » (« PREISLEGENDE ») if you scratch off three or more complete words in a single crossword puzzle in accordance with the provisions.
 - You win the amount in the corresponding « PRIZE » (« GEWINN ») field if you scratch off all the letters of the « BONUS WORD » in full.

Note: combined wins are possible; a player can win up to 3 times on one instant ticket.

Provisions

- A word consists of a minimum of three letters and is shown exclusively horizontally from left to right or vertically from top to bottom.
- A word is demarcated by either black fields and/or the edge of the game area.
- A word only counts as a full word when all the letters within the depicted area are uncovered, with this word counting as one word (e.g.: SANDBOX does not count as the two words SAND and BOX).
